This facility utilizes an Integrated Pest Management (IPM) approach in the maintenance of this golf course. We take a holistic approach toward control of weed, insect and disease pests on the golf course by utilizing a wide variety of pest control methods including proper watering and fertilization schedules, use of pest-resistant plant varieties, and use of proper mowing schedules.

While our IPM approach attempts to reduce the need for the use of pesticides, it is sometimes necessary to use pesticides at this facility to control weeds, insects or plant disease pests.

If pesticides are applied at this facility, we will post notices regarding the application at the first (1st) and tenth (10th) tees. The notices will be placed from the time of the application until such time that any specific product label reentry requirements have been fulfilled.
